The **Academy** offers a creative environment equipped with a nursery, childrens' gym, bright, spacious playrooms, decorated with childrens' artwork, a dining area, nap rooms, Imaginatorium and outdoor playground.

INFANT NURSERY/Toddler Teens Program (3 Months - 12 Months & 12 Months - 18 Months)

Infants enrolled in the program adhere to their own individual schedule throughout the day. Information provided by the parents is used to plan each child's day according to his / her needs. As a result, feeding, diapering, and napping are each an integral part of the daily curriculum.

TODDLERS

(18 Months - 2 1/2 Years)

Toddlers are provided with the opportunity to gain a sense of mastery over their environment through Exploration and play. Creativity and freedom of choice are encouraged as toddlers assert their independence.

TODDLER PLUS

(2 1/2 Years—3 1/2 Years)

This is a unique program with a strong focus on self mastery skills. This program offers one to one attention from the caregivers encouraging skills such as self dressing, potty learning, and age appropriate group interactions.

PRESCHOOL PREP I & II

(3 1/2 Years—4 1/2 Years & 4 1/2 Years to 5 1/2 Years)

The Preschool Program offers a wide variety of Experiences. Through weekly themes, the children learn new concepts, allowing them to extend their play and to share individual interests and ideas.

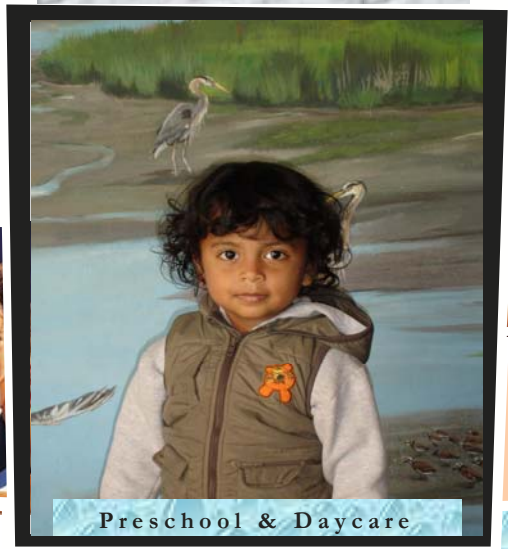
